The Geneva, Ohio Fire Department Wraps Up Their Fire Truck

As is the case with many cities around the country, budgets strain to meet the ever increasing needs of the community. In Geneva, Ohio, the situation was no different. The increasing growth and demands of the community for the fire department required an investment in a new ladder truck. The first step was to find a truck at the right price. Chief Doug Starkey and the team were able to find a great pre-owned truck from a local community that fit into the budget. The problem? It needed a new paint job...in a big way.
